Submission on the Copyright Bill

1. Preamble

The blindness sector represented by the SA National Council for the Blind and (over 100 member organisations) SA Disability Alliance (representing seventeen National Disable People's Organisation (DPO), Disability Service Organisations, Parent's Organisations and Professional Bodies) have been advocating for the past decade for exceptions and limitations in the Copyright Act to enable full and equal access to published works by persons with disability.

In South Africa less than zero point five percent (0.5%) of published works were available in an accessible format. These were largely produced by the NGO sector. The lack of access to published works resulted in very low levels of literacy and resulted in the "book famine".

The coming into force of the Marrakesh Treaty on 30 September 2016 and to date with twenty nine countries ratifying Marrakesh Treaty will provide hope of empowering blind and partially sighted persons and persons with print disability access to knowledge and information.

The presentation of the Copyright Bill to Parliament is acknowledged and the sector looks forward to the enactment of the Copyright Bill and the ratification of the Marrakesh Treaty.

2. Comments

2.1 Definition

The definition of "person with disability" and "accessibility" is in line with international and national best practice.
